**[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING MIDWEST CLASS PLAINTIFFS'  
MOTION FOR APPROVAL OF PLAN OF DISTRIBUTION TO  
THE CHAMPAIGN NON-ARBITRATION CLASS AND  
PARTIAL REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES**

NOW before the Court is the Midwest Plaintiffs' Motion for Approval of Distribution to the Champaign Non-Arbitration Class and Partial Reimbursement of Expenses.

The Court has reviewed the Motion, its accompanying memorandum, declaration and the exhibits thereto, and the file in this matter. Accordingly,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. Midwest Plaintiffs' proposed plan of distribution, as detailed in the Motion, to distribute the Net Settlement Fund (the settlement amount less approved expenses and a reserve for a future motion for attorneys' fees and service award for Plaintiff D&G, Inc. d/b/a Gary's Foods) to qualified members of the Settlement Class is GRANTED;

2. Co-Lead Counsel's request for partial reimbursement of expenses from the Settlement Fund to Co-Lead Counsel, Boies, Schiller & Flexner LLP, Kotchen & Low LLP, and Lockridge Grindal Nauen P.L.L.P. of \$1.5 million is GRANTED; and

3. Midwest Plaintiffs' request to reserve and hold in escrow 30 percent of the gross Settlement Fund for a potential future award of attorneys' fees, \$10,000 as a potential service award to Class Representative D&G, and amounts as detailed in the Motion for claims administration, taxes, and escrow fees is GRANTED.
